WHAT'S NEW THIS YEAR

Programmes for Academic Session 2026-27

A new academic year, a fresh slate of programmes designed to build stronger minds and warmer hearts. Here is what your child will experience this year. Many of them are brand new, all of them rooted in the same belief: that learning works best when it feels real.



D.E.A.R. Time

GRADES 1-10

Drop Everything And Read. 15 minutes after break time, every single day. Story books, novels, biographies, knowledge books, whatever your child loves. The goal isn't a reading list. It's a lifelong reading habit. We're building a school-wide culture where, for fifteen minutes, the whole campus pauses to read.



Concept Clarity Programme

GRADES 1-9

Every learner starts at a different place. Through baseline assessments in English and Mathematics, we identify exactly where each child is, then offer **focused Concept Clarity classes during Zero Period** to close any learning gaps. The goal: stronger foundations, deeper understanding, more confidence.



Child-Parent-Teacher Dialogue

GRADES 6-9 • CPTD

A reimagined parent-teacher meeting, except this time, **the child leads it**. Students walk parents and teachers through their own progress, portfolios, and goals. Parents become learning partners; teachers become guides. The result: ownership, self-reflection, and a child who knows exactly where they're going.



Career Awareness

GRADES 8 AND ABOVE

Stream selection shouldn't be a guess. Through **aptitude analysis, personality profiling, and exposure to emerging career pathways**, we help students understand who they are and where they could thrive. From traditional professions to the careers being invented today, they meet them all.
