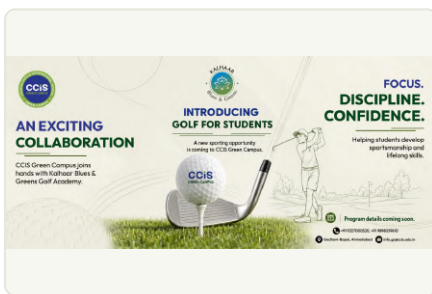
Career Counselling Begins

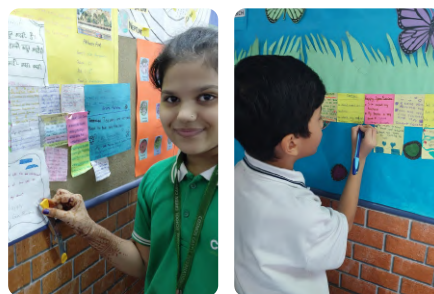

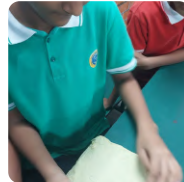
Club Corner

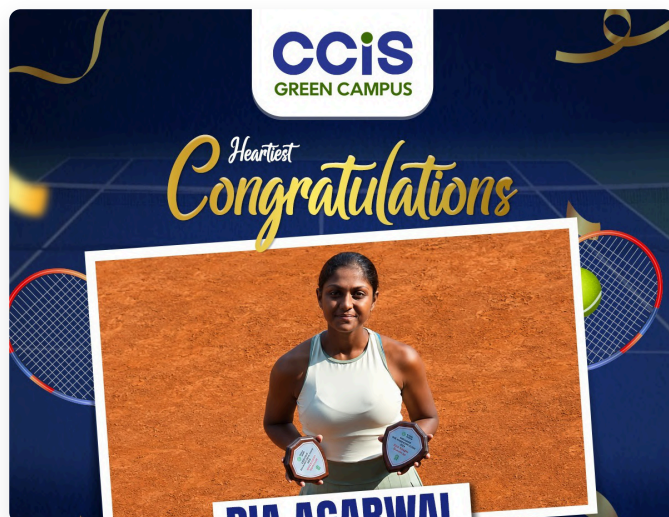

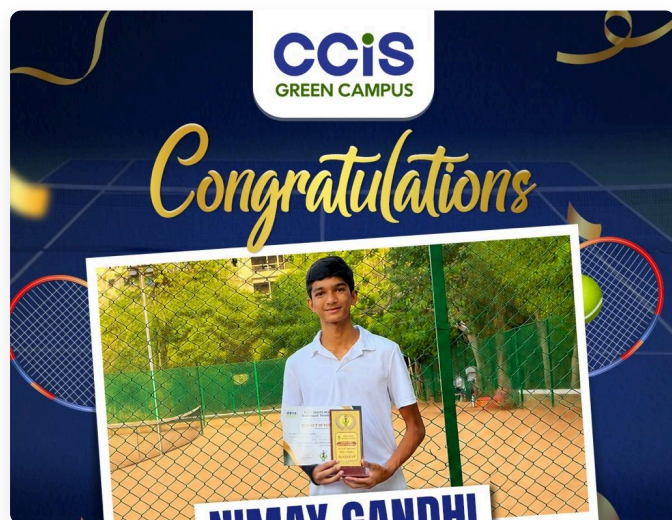
July was a big month on the tennis court. Four CCIS Green Campus students carried our name from state to international tournaments, and all came home with silverware.

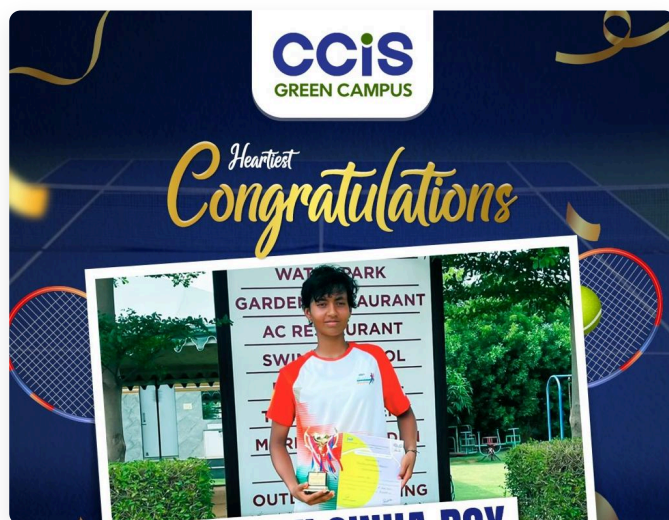
