Career Cluster Project • Grades 9 & 10

As part of our Career & College Counselling initiative, a workshop introduced Grades 9 and 10 to the diverse career opportunities available across different fields, broadening their understanding beyond the few conventional options they may already know. Through the Career Cluster Project, students will now work in groups to explore, research, and present findings on their assigned cluster: career opportunities within it, emerging and lesser-known options, career pathways and requirements, starting salaries and progression, leading individuals and organisations in the field, and reliable sources of information.

Each group will prepare a 9-slide presentation and an A3 poster, presenting during **Career Week, 21-26 September**, with 8-10 minutes per group followed by Q&A. Teacher Cluster Leads will guide students throughout, with the goal not to decide on a career immediately, but to discover possibilities and make more informed choices for the future.
