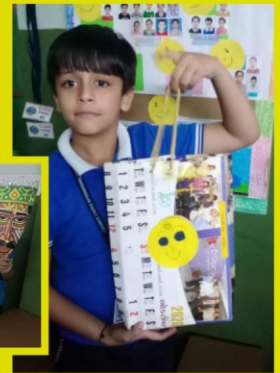
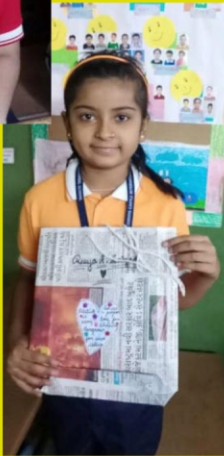
WORLD NATURE CONSERVATION DAY

FITNESS AND HYGIENE WEEK

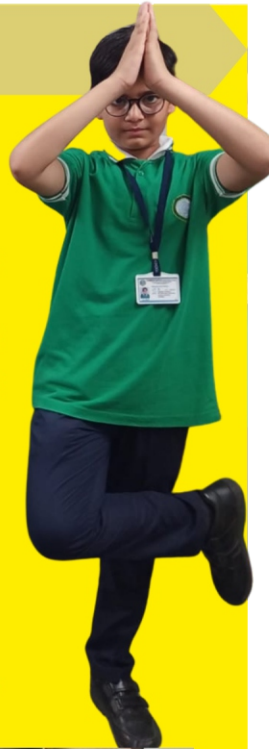
